Follow these simple steps and breathe easy knowing you're helping keep your home and family safe.

- ☒ Book an annual gas safety check with a legally qualified Gas Safe registered engineer.
- ☒ Always ask to see your engineer's Gas Safe ID card.
- ☒ Install a carbon monoxide (CO) alarm — CO has no smell, taste or colour and it is deadly.
- ☒ Know the symptoms of CO poisoning: headaches, dizziness, breathlessness, nausea, collapse and loss of consciousness.
- ☒ Never attempt DIY gas work.
- ☒ Report unsafe gas work to Gas Safe Register.

If you rent your home, your landlord is responsible for arranging an annual gas safety check, providing you with a copy of the gas safety record, and installing CO alarms.

Gas Safe Register is the official list of engineers qualified to work safely and legally on gas appliances. **Checking your engineer is registered gives you peace of mind that you're in safe hands.**
